



This growth will bring employment, apprenticeship and training opportunities for our residents and commercial opportunities for our businesses.


The Council wants to support businesses to grow, new businesses to start up and to attract new investment to Harrow – this is a great borough to be based in.



About Harrow



Harrow is an extremely attractive location for investment, benefiting from a thriving and diverse community, outstanding schools, skilled workers, excellent accessibility and a high level of community safety. The diversity of ethnicity and faith is reflected in mosques, temples, synagogues and historic churches: a cultural offer that celebrates every corner of the globe.

Harrow retains a sense of unique heritage through historic sites that celebrate its Norman, Tudor, and industrial past, in addition to its 20th century role as capital of Metroland.

Harrow is ideally located in North-West London, approximately 14 minutes from Central London.

Recognised as an area with a rich heritage, Harrow is one of London's most attractive suburban areas with over a quarter of the borough (more than 1,300 hectares) consisting of open space. Harrow covers an area of approximately 50 sq. km (just under 20 square miles).

With an estimated resident population of 246,000 (2014 ONS Population Estimates) Harrow has one of the most ethnically diverse populations in the country and is the seventh least deprived London borough, an improved ranking since 2007.

Harrow benefits from both the vibrancy and diversity related to London combined with a green and leafy environment. The result is a borough with one of the highest standards of living in London.

Boasting a wide range of quality and attractive housing, a low crime rate, good hospitals, a reputation for consistently high standards in education, superb transport links and great recreational facilities, no wonder Harrow has a lot to offer any business wishing to be based here.

Today the area's vibrant economy and business opportunities, combined with its excellent housing, education and leisure facilities, make Harrow an unbeatable location.

Coupled with this, future regeneration plans for the borough will change the landscape of Harrow and Wealdstone town centres, and lead to thousands of new homes, schools, parks, transport links and other public facilities.

Harrow's Economy

Harrow offers great growth opportunities for both new and existing businesses. Its diverse business base, operating across a range of sectors, has enabled Harrow to enjoy economic resilience during the recession. Economic activity levels in Harrow are high (70%) and unemployment is low (1% in April 2016). Both the number of jobs and the number of people working in Harrow have increased.

About Harrow

Our track record of growth owes much to the diversity of the population. The Centre for Entrepreneurs and DueDil Report stated that one in every seven new companies in the UK was set up by migrant entrepreneurs. And Harrow was the fourth most popular UK destination for migrants to start a business, with almost 12,000 migrant-founded companies.

The borough has a thriving economy characterised by strong entrepreneurial activity. In 2015 the Inter Departmental Business Register (IDBR), showed that

there were around 12,385 businesses in Harrow. 93% of these are small enterprises employing fewer than ten people.

In terms of sectors for Harrow, in 2015 (ONS IDBR), the highest concentration of businesses was Professional, Scientific and Technical based, with 2,280 (22%) businesses. This is the most dominant sector nationally, in London and in West London. Harrow's second largest group, based on the number of businesses, is Information and Communication with 15% of

businesses with Construction third at 11.7%. Within West London and London, Information and Communication is also ranked second, and nationally it is ranked fourth.

The economic strengths of the area which will support Harrow's future growth are good public transport accessibility, high rates of new business formation and entrepreneurship, a highly qualified workforce and a high proportion of knowledge-based businesses.




- One of London's designated Opportunity Areas, with the capacity to deliver significant increases in new homes and jobs
- Over 20 identified sites for development, all deliverable in the short and medium term
- The Harrow Local Plan has identified that 3,000 additional jobs could be created through comprehensive and co-ordinated regeneration within the Harrow and Wealdstone Opportunity Area
- Excellent national and city connectivity - 14 minutes from Euston, close to the M1, M25 and M40 motorways, good access to Heathrow airport, with four underground lines and national rail links

- Economic activity rate showing a general upward trend and, at 77.4% (year ending September 2015), very similar to London's rate; its overall employment rate at 73.6% is higher than that of London and Great Britain
- At 1% (April 2016), the unemployment rate in Harrow was below the rates for West London, London and England
- 12,385 businesses in the borough (2015)
- A well qualified workforce –
 52% of working age residents held a degree level qualification in 2013 and only 3.7% of residents were lacking in qualifications

- A significantly high proportion of Harrow residents hold other qualifications, which includes foreign qualifications and some professional qualifications. At 13%, this proportion is twice the national rate of 6.3%
- Students in Harrow's schools and colleges are high achievers as attainment in Harrow's schools is consistently above national averages at all levels
- The proportion of young people aged 16 to 18 who were not in education, employment or training (NEET) in Harrow is 1.8%, the joint lowest level in the country
- Over a fifth of Harrow land is designated as Green Belt



The Ideal Location



Harrow is a great place to live and work. It has quality housing, great parks and open spaces and a wonderful heritage and leisure offer. On top of all this, it plays a key part in London's economy.

Harrow businesses benefit from great connections to central London and to the north and south west of England by both road and rail networks.

Rail

The borough is strategically located to offer excellent transport links to central London, which includes a 14-minute direct rail link into Euston. It is well served by both mainline rail and underground services. Four underground lines cross the borough - the Metropolitan, Jubilee, Bakerloo and Piccadilly lines with stations situated across the borough. There are 13 stations in Harrow and five just outside the borough.

Mainline rail services are provided by Chiltern Railways, London Midland and Southern Railways, with services to Central London, Milton Keynes, East Croydon, Watford and Aylesbury.


Road

Road links are good, with a major road network which links to the M1, M25 and M40 motorways. The Piccadilly line and the 140 Bus provide direct links between Harrow and Heathrow Airport. Both Heathrow and Luton Airport are easily accessible by road and public transport.

Its location, and the nature of its business, ensures that Harrow enjoys high employment growth and low levels of unemployment.





Discover Hidden Harrow

Harrow has over 900 years of history for you to get out and discover.

The name Harrow is derived from an Anglo-Saxon word, meaning 'temple' or 'sacred grove'.

With communities dating back to before the Domesday Book, Harrow has enjoyed a rich legacy of famous historical figures. Follow the Harrow Heritage Trails and visit the key heritage sights of the borough. Discover Harrow's Hill and take in the fantastic views that inspired the young Lord Byron.

Go back to the land, and uncover Harrow's agricultural past on a visit to Harrow Museum's medieval estate. While there, experience the eerie atmosphere of the 14th century Headstone Manor, where monks are said to be heard chanting in the grounds.

Children can let off steam all year round at a wide variety of inclusive play facilities. If it all gets too much, simply relax with a picnic and watch the sun set over London, far from the madding crowds.

Focus on Harrow Town Centre



Harrow's town centre is regarded as one of the UK's top retail centres and is one of only twelve Metropolitan centres within London, offering a variety of shops, restaurants, banks and building societies, coffee shops and a great department store.

The main shopping area offers two modern shopping complexes and is home to such high street favourites as Debenhams, Marks & Spencer, Next, TK Maxx and Primark, a variety of small independent retailers and a large cinema complex.

The town centre area is home to over 400 businesses, with 27% of Harrow's office-based employment located here, making this a core business location in Harrow and vital to the borough's economy.

The area benefits from excellent transport links via Harrow-on-the-Hill station and the main bus terminus connecting the area to adjoining boroughs and beyond, as well as central London.

Harrow Town Centre Business Improvement District (BID)

The BID began in April 2014 and is set to end on 31st March 2019. The BID will see over £1.5m invested into the town centre over the next five years, focusing on town centre management, a programme of events and attractions and the continued improvements to the town's streetscape.

Other Centres in Harrow

As well as the town centre, Harrow has one major centre, Edgware, nine District Centres and five Local Centres.

Together, they showcase the types of businesses trading in Harrow; providing a significant number of jobs for local residents as well as providing for social and community needs. Some of these are described below:

Hatch End

Hatch End is a unique, fashionable shopping area with a choice of stylish restaurants and a wide range of businesses for goods or services, leisure or pleasure. There is a local traders' association serving the business community of Hatch End.

North Harrow

North Harrow is a popular commercial area offering a variety of amenities, a selection of retailers, restaurants, take-aways & cafés, and plenty of independent specialist shops, plus the Metropolitan Line station.

Pinner's historic High Street sells everything from wooden toys to wedding hats and offers stalls selling fresh seasonal fruit and vegetables at Pinner's weekly farmers' market. It is now wholly a pleasure fair, visited annually by over 40,000 people.


Stanmore

Stanmore Broadway has excellent shopping facilities and is served by the Jubilee Line tube.
